Lee Taylor accepted Christ at Hume Lake Christian Camp as a 7th grader when he went with Quail Lakes Baptist Church, and then was baptized as a sophomore in high school. Beta (Brazilian) was accepted Christ at a different Christian camp in Brazil, continued to grow throughout high school and college, and was Baptized in 2009. They were both convicted in 2012 when watching a video expressing God's lack of interest in lukewarm Christians.

exchange students went to a Friday night bible study with Lee, but Beta was the only one who kept going the whole semester! Lee thought that was a good "sign", and after some long distance dating, and some long distance marriage (waiting for the visa), they have now celebrated their 3 year wedding anniversary.

Lee was a physical education teacher for students with disabilities in Stockton, California and is now teaching physical education to the high school students at the Rain Forest International School for missionary kids in Yaoundé, Cameroon. He is also working with a local leader to help Cameroonian youths know Christ through a volleyball ministry.

Beta worked as a volleyball coach and a personal trainer in the states. She is now helping to teach physical education to the elementary aged students as well as the high-schoolers. She has been coaching soccer and volleyball as well as meeting one-on-one with students to help them grow in the Lord.

The Taylors are amazed that the Lord has opened the perfect opportunities for them to serve for this one-year term in Cameroon. They are looking forward to see what doors God will continue to open during and after this opportunity.
