Disciple-Makers in Japan



During their first term of missionary service, Nick and Iris launched their ministries in Kano and Mambilla Plateau, Nigeria, focusing on theological education and evangelism among Muslims and Chinese migrants. In addition, God granted Nick and Iris opportunities to care for those in need through visits to hospitals and prisons. Providing aid to villagers in rural areas opened the door for them to share the Gospel with the unreached.

Afterward, they served in China for more than a decade, until the end of 2023. Evangelism, discipleship, and Christian counselling were their main ministries in China, along with organizing summer camps, ministering to left-behind children, and establishing a care and support fellowship for those affected by divorce.

They were also deeply involved in pastoral ministry, while serving together with national ministers in the local churches. Unfortunately, they were unable to continue their missionary service on the mainland due to massive reinforcement of the national control and restrictions to religions.

In 2024, God directed them to serve in Japan, where a significant number of Chinese migrants have settled over the past decade. It is estimated that 1.2 million Chinese people are currently residing in Japan, with less than 0.3 percent of this diaspora identifying as Christians. Even before Nick and Iris landed in Japan, they started learning the Japanese language and culture. While they continue their studies, they have been able to connect with Chinese-speaking people, building relationships and sharing the Gospel with them.

Their ministries focus on reaching out to Chinese migrants and students in Japan for evangelism and discipleship. By the grace of God, they started children and teenager ministries in a Japanese church. Recently, they received an invitation to partner with a new missionary couple to serve the Chinese community in the Tokyo area, with a vision to plant a Chinese church in the future.
