We arrived back in Cameroon on August 1<sup>st</sup> with only four days together at home before taking the girls to Yaoundé for school. Rain Forest International School (rfis.org) began classes on August 7<sup>th</sup>. Ysabelle is in 12<sup>th</sup> grade and Elianna in 9<sup>th</sup>. They have settled back into the hostel that is their home away from home while at school. It was a great reunion to meet up with all their friends again.



While in Yaoundé, Susie chaired the first school board meeting of the year. This is her second year serving as chair of the RFIS board. The administrator (principal) of the school has just announced her resignation after serving the school for the past ten years. Susie and the board now have the task of recruiting and hiring a new school administrator over the next 12 months. Stay tuned for further information about this opportunity and need.

### *Cameroon & Security*

The socio-political crisis in Cameroon continues to grow and spread. While we still feel safe and secure where we are, some of our missionary colleagues have had to evacuate their areas. Others have witnessed violence around them. The next few months will be quite uncertain with the national presidential election scheduled for early October.

As NAB Field Director and CBC Director of Cooperating Missions, Calvin monitors the security situation daily in order to update and advise all missionary personnel serving under the Cameroon Baptist Convention.
