

Lindsey GelinasMissionary in Japan



Lindsey Gelinas was born in Edmonton, Alberta, as the youngest of six children. Church was a constant in her childhood, which she attended with her whole family. Sunday school and a weekly Bible memorization program (AWANA) helped develop a love of church and the Bible in her life. In her teenage years, Lindsey was a regular attender of her youth group at Northgate Baptist Church. In those years, her faith grew much stronger, and she chose to be baptized at the age of 15 on Easter Sunday.

Upon Lindsey's first missions trip to Tijuana, Mexico, she felt God calling her to life-long missionary service overseas. With this calling upon her heart, she made plans to attend Vanguard College's missions program in Edmonton, Alberta. Through the classes, friendships, experiences, and mentorships offered at Vanguard, Lindsey only grew in knowledge and love of the Lord.
