Zoli has been chopping plenty of wood to keep us well stocked for the winter.

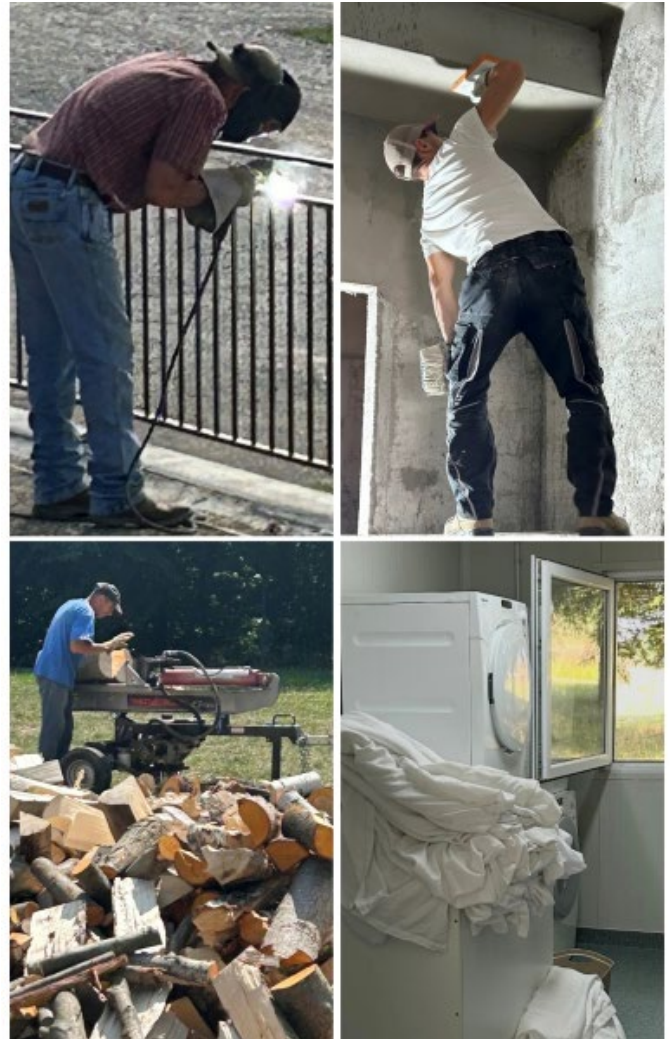
And Gloria can always be found in the laundry room, tackling a mountain of bedding every week.
